ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be expected to graduate from high school between December 1, 2011 and June 30, 2012.

Applicants must have been accepted to a four-year college, two-year college, community college, proprietary school or private career college.

An educator from the student's school district must have attended the Indiana Conference on Learning on January 24, 2012. Applicants must submit a complete application by the deadline.

AWARD CRITERIA

Rigor of high school course selection.

Personal statement

NOTE: GPA and Class Rank will not be taken into consideration.

AWARD AMOUNT

The one-time award will be in the amount of \$500 or greater depending on funds donated by attendees at the Indiana Conference on Learning.
